Re-joicing with God: Hoping as we Lament

Romans 8:26-39

- In the same way the Spirit also helps our weakness; for we do not know how to pray as we should, but the Spirit Himself intercedes for us with groanings too deep for words; and
- He who searches the hearts knows what the mind of the Spirit is, because He intercedes for the saints according to the will of God.
- And we know that God causes all things to work together for good to those who love God, to those who are called according to His purpose....
